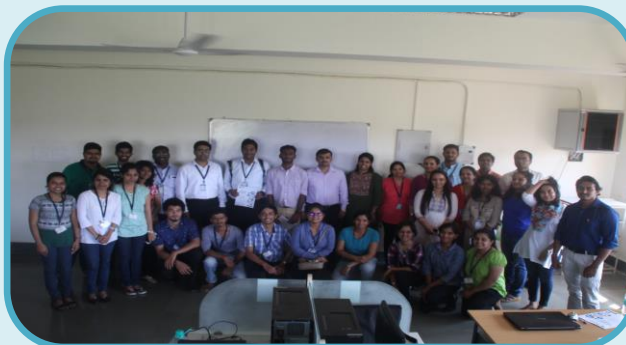

“PATW 2017 – a first ever IET global event organized at Goa”

The PATW competition, which was open to Engineering and Technology students across the state of Goa, aims to find the young engineer or technologist with the strongest presentation skills. About 55 Engineering and Technology students representing two Engineering Institutions including Goa Engineering College and Agnel Institute of Technology and Design across different disciplines such as Computer, Electrical & Electronics, Electronics & Communication and Mechanical Engineering participated in the event.

Each participant was allowed to present his/her related to Engineering topic in front of the panel comprising of 2 Judges and other participants. Each participant was given 10 minutes for his/her presentation after which Judges were allowed to ask the questions. Judging is based on the presenter's presentation skills (70%) and its technical content (30%).

First round of the event started at 9.15 am. Three parallel sessions were conducted in three different venues - Communication and Networking Lab, Software Project management Lab and Graphics and Signal processing laboratories of Computer Engineering department. Each session was judged by a panel of two Judges. Based on the judging criteria of PATW, a Winner & a Runner Up from each session were selected.

Grand Finale – Goa University level...

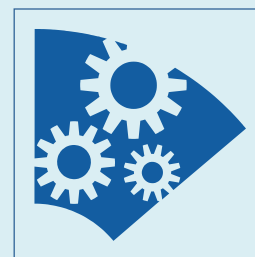
The finals of Goa University level PATW Competition started at 2.30pm in which Winner & Runner up of each of the three sessions competed against each other.
