


5. Nurturing Intelligence for Curious Engineers (NICE) 2019 Competition


Ms. Dhriti Amlani and Mast. Raheel Shaikh (TECOMP) secured the 1st and 2nd place respectively.


8. Preliminary Round of State level Quiz by Yi CII



AITD won the Best College Award at the Rotaract Entrepreneurship Summit 2020 along with the First Place for the Startup Competition and Chit Chat.






